









Municipality Background



Major town within the Northern Rift; regional trade and transport hub and IAAF World Heritage Site.

Vision: A town of choice for sports, tourism and investment

- •Headquarters of Elgeyo Marakwet County, one of the eight counties in the Northern Rift Economic Block (NOREB).
- •Major agriculture hub; 80% of the residents engage in agriculture (small scale farmers).
- •Located along three ecological zones i.e. the highlands, escarpments and valley; ideal for producing Irish potatoes, groundnuts, honey and assorted fruits.
- •Training ground for athletes; receives over 1,500 foreign sports tourists p.a. and hosts one leg of the global paragliding season.
- •Well developed infrastructure within the municipality including hospitals, a recreational park, sports stadium which is under construction, running tracks, banks etc.
- •Seeking to increasing industrialisation especially value addition through the establishment of a Special Economic Zone and SME dedicated parks and sports tourism



Irish Potato Processing





Processing of Irish potatoes into frozen and fresh potato fries; an estimated USD 1 billion market in East Africa

Project description


- •Greenfield opportunity to process Irish potatoes into frozen and fresh potato fries for fast food outlets.
- Elgeyo Marakwet is the second largest producer of Irish potatoes nationally; estimated 4,443 farmers producing 300,000 MT of Irish potatoes p.a.
- Processing capacity of 50,000 MT p.a.
- CAPEX of \$22 million.
- Estimated IRR of between 5% and 45%.

Project opportunity

- Irish potato is the 2nd most consumed crop after maize.
- Demand is catalyzed by the burgeoning hospitality sector and urban population.
- Market gap in the form of unmet demand for locally produced frozen fries in light of the increased 30% import duty on the commodity.

Investment incentive

- •Designated land for the facility provided by the Municipality and related amenities such as water, waste management site and access road to the facility.
- •Guaranteed quality raw material as a result of seedling distribution and capacity building by Elgeyo Marakwet County in partnership with institutions such as KALRO and ILRI to farmers.





Groundnut Processing



Investing in pioneer production of Ready to Use Therapeutic Foods (RUTF) in East Africa and sports energy bars.

Project description


- •Greenfield opportunity to manufacture RUTF, peanut butter and sports energy bars.
- Iten produces c. 40% of the groundnuts in Kenya from c. 2,000 farmers across NOREB
- Processing capacity of 108MT groundnuts p.a.
- CAPEX of \$2 million.
- •Estimated IRR of between 10% and 15%.

Project opportunity

- •RUTF is used to feed the under nourished either in schools, refugee camps or health centres.
- Current market of at least million malnourished children in Kenya. UNICEF and WHO import RUFT from other countries to cater for this demand.
- Project could also catalyse further investment in Iten

Investment incentive

- •Guaranteed quality raw materials as Egerton University is working with the farmers to enhance groundnut quality.
- •Designated land for the facility provided by the Municipality and related amenities such as water, waste management site and access road to the facility.







Sports Hub Centre



Construction of a sports hub in Iten hosting a high performance centre and sports medicine facility; the first in Eastern Africa

Project description

- •Greenfield opportunity to construct a sports hub in Iten hosting a high performance centre and sports medicine facility.
- The sports medicine facility specialise in athletes' well being e.g. physiotherapy, mental health, nutrition etc.
- Proposed Iten location has ideal topography for low and high altitude training.

Project opportunity

- •Globally, sports tourism generates USD 600 billion with a growth of 4% p.a.
- Opportunity to capitalize on this growth by investigating the potential to develop high performance training academies in the athletics field at Iten municipality.
- Project provides an avenue for realizing vision by leveraging on Iten's reputation as the home of champions and its sports heritage to attract tourists.

Investment incentive

- •Designated land for the facility provided by the Municipality and related amenities such as water, waste management site and access road to the facility.
- •Elgeyo Marakwet County (EMC) will authorize the use of the County brand as the home of champions to market the facility. Iten is also recognized as a IAAF World Heritage location
